### PROOF OF AGE: KINDERGARTEN - FIRST GRADE

AR 2130.2

Before pupils are enrolled a birth certificate or other recognized proof of age must be presented for those who enter kindergarten or first grade for the first time in this District. Documents which will be accepted as proof of age (pursuant to Education Code Section 48002) consist of the following, provided that they contain the day, month, and year of the pupil's birth and that they appear valid and unaltered:

1. Certificate of birth (includes certificate of birth issued at hospital).
2. Baptism certificate duly attested.
3. Passport.
4. Affidavit of the parent, guardian, or custodian of the minor.
5. Written statement by the local registrar or a county recorder certifying the date of birth.

Attention is directed to the legal requirement that proof of age must be submitted before a pupil may enter kindergarten or first grade. Only one of the above types of documentary evidence which contains the day, month, and year of birth will be necessary.

Beginners to kindergarten or first grade received by transfer from another school district in the State will be required to present one of the above types of documentary evidence when they enter this District.
