If a student is in danger of failing a course and prior to the last grading period in the semester received a grade of C- or higher on his/her report card, the teacher shall request a conference with, or mail a written report to, the student's parent/guardian. In this instance, a failing grade may be assigned only if the parent/guardian has been notified of the possible failure in adequate time for the student to meet the minimum requirements of the course.

During the second semester, the high schools will establish a procedure and time line to provide notification for parents/guardians of any senior who is in danger of failing a course. A failing grade may be assigned only if the parent/guardian has been notified.
