AR 2320.1

Special Days

The secondary schools of the District may plan special days and other all-school activities in accordance with the following guidelines:

1. The responsible parties for the planning of special student activities shall be the president of the Student Body or designee, the Student Activities Advisor, and the school Principal or designee.
2. The initiation of a proposed student activity may be any of the described responsible parties.
3. The proposed activity in its entirety must be approved by all three parties.
4. Special days or events shall not exceed one per month, nor more than nine per year at high schools; one per quarter, nor more than four per year at middle schools.

The special days or events required by this regulation shall not include previously established traditional activities or extensions thereof.

5. The special day or event shall be so planned and executed that there is no disruption of the ongoing academic program.

Since responsibility for the day-to-day operation of the school and its activities rests with the school principal, he/she shall have and shall exercise categorical control over all of the day-to-day activities of the school, the staff, and the student body.
