SUSPENSION - SYSTEMATIC

AR 2430.2

The program for "systematic suspension" for both elementary and secondary students is as follows:

1. In instances where other corrective measures have not brought about the desired results with the pupil who is a persistent classroom behavior problem, the pupil may be placed on systematic suspension.
2. The principal may take the pupil home that day providing there is a responsible adult there to receive him/her.
3. The pupil may return to the classroom on the next day on condition that his/her behavior is satisfactory to the teacher.
4. The pupil may be denied class participation each day that his/her behavior is unsatisfactory to the teacher; however, he/she must be admitted each day to his/her class for a reasonable number of days as determined by the principal.
5. In those cases where there is no parent/guardian at home, the principal should contact the responsible parent/guardian and inform him/her that the child will not be permitted to attend class the following school day. While at home the pupil is in the custody of the parent/guardian.
