EVALUATION OF CONSOLIDATED PROGRAMS

AR 3129

An annual evaluation of the effectiveness of consolidated programs based on the criteria delineated will be made. If a school program is found to be ineffective, the Deputy Superintendent or designee will assist the school in developing a plan to improve student performance and to meet the criteria.

Each school site will annually evaluate the extent to which the school has accomplished or made significant progress toward achieving the target growth on the statewide Academic Performance Index (API), aggregated for each numerically significant student group, along with other measures of student progress contained in school plans.

Annually, each School Site Council (SSC) will review the evaluation results for each numerically significant student group and propose changes in curriculum materials, instructional practices, staff development and related categorical expenditures needed to meet the API growth targets for each student group and the goals/objectives of the school plan.

A summary of the evaluation will be given to the Board annually.
