CERTIFICATED PERSONNEL

EXAMINATION FOR TUBERCULOSIS

AR 4114

Persons initially employed in a certificated position must furnish proof to the Personnel Office that within the past 60 days they have been examined and found free of active tuberculosis. This examination must be verified by a licensed physician and must consist of an approved intradermal tuberculin test (Mantoux Test) per the California Education Code; if the test is positive, it must be followed by an x-ray of the lungs.

After initial employment all personnel are required to have an additional examination every four years and submit evidence of freedom from active tuberculosis.

Reminder notices shall be sent by the Personnel Office to those employees who need a new test. Employees failing to adhere to this mandate shall be denied the opportunity to engage in summer employment or to resume their teaching assignment in September until evidence of an appropriate examination has been received in the Personnel Office.

Nothing in this section shall prevent the Board of Education from establishing a rule requiring a more extensive physical examination.
