INSTRUCTION

SCHOOL-BASED COORDINATION PROGRAM

BP 3161

It shall be the policy of the Board of Education to support and encourage the participation of schools in the School-Based Program Coordination Act to provide greater flexibility in coordinating funds and improving services for eligible students.

State-funded programs that may be included in the School-Based Coordination Program (SBCP) are:

- School Improvement Program
- Gifted and Talented
- Economic Impact Aid - Limited English Proficient (LEP)
- Economic Impact Aid - State Compensatory Education (SCE)
- Miller-Unruh Reading Act
- Special Education

Schools with SB 65 funds may also include:

- Adult Education
- Continuation Education
- Regional Occupational Centers
- Work Experience Education

Each school electing to participate shall ensure that funds coordinated under SBCP shall be used to supplement, not supplant, existing State and local fiscal efforts.

Compliance with all requirements of State and Federal laws shall be maintained.
