


AGSHIP

Downey High School's Early College Program is designed for students who want to get a head start for college




TAKE COLLEGE CLASSES

COMPLETE HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS





Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC)

- This plan is designed primarily for students who intend to transfer to the University of California (UC) or who are undecided between UC and California State University (CSU)
- Students will take General Education courses from the IGETC Curriculum
- Earn up to 43.5 Transferable College Units if students successfully complete the full four-year Early College Program

COLLEGE FRESHMAN




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TRANSFER STUDENT





CLASS INFORMATION

- Students will complete A-G requirements (exceptions are: COUN 101A & READ 101)
- Students will receive a GPA bump for certain **Cerritos College classes**
- Cerritos College classes will be 0 and 1st period; **Downey High School classes will be 2nd – 6th** period.
- College classes will be offered on DHS campus
- All classes will be taught by Cerritos College faculty



PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- 8th Grade GPA of 3.0 or higher desired
- Complete Early College application
- Interview Process by Downey High School staff may be included
- 4-year student commitment

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HOW IS COLLEGE DIFFERENT FROM HIGH SCHOOL?

PASSING CLASSES

Students will need to pass college classes with a grade of C or better

COMMUNICATION

Students will be communicating with their college instructors



TIME MANAGEMENT

Students will have to learn time management to balance high school work and college work

HOW IS COLLEGE DIFFERENT FROM HIGH SCHOOL?

STUDENTS

Students are treated as college students
