

# PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Downey High School's Early College Program is designed for students who want to get a head start for college.



## College Courses:

Students will take Cerritos College classes at Downey High School and will complete up to 43.5 transferable units to a CSU or UC.

## High School Graduation Requirements:

Students will complete their graduation requirements.

## May begin taking courses in the summer:

2 cohorts of 30 8<sup>th</sup> grade students will be selected to participate in the program starting Fall 2026

### SAVE MONEY:


Free tuition and books

Opportunity to earn their certificate of completion for general education as long as the students pass their college courses with a C or better


### COLLEGE SERVICES:

Cerritos College classes will be offered within the DHS school day


All classes will be taught by Cerritos College faculty

## COST COMPARISON FOR GENERAL ED. CLASSES

### SAMPLE COLLEGE COST SAVINGS FOR EARLY COLLEGE PROGRAM

2 years of cost savings of up to \$28,000 (UC) and \$11,600 (CSU) by completing General Education classes.

## How is College Different from High School

### Passing Classes

Students will need to pass college classes with a grade of C or better.

### Communication

Students will be communicating with their college instructors.

### Time Management

Students will have to learn time management to balance high school work and college work.

### Students

Students are treated as college students.

### FERPA

The Family Educational Right & Privacy Act (FERPA): Cerritos College cannot release personal information of the student's education record without prior written consent from the student.


## CALIFORNIA GENERAL EDUCATION TRANSFER CURRICULUM (CAL-GETC)

Cal-GETC is a standardized general education pathway for students planning to transfer to a University of California (UC) or California State University (CSU) campus.

Through the Early College Program, students:

- Complete approved Cal-GETC general education courses
- Earn up to 43.5 UC/CSU-transferable college units
- May qualify for Cal-GETC certification upon completion of all courses with a C or better

Cal-GETC certification may satisfy lower-division general education requirements at participating UC and CSU campuses. Additional coursework may be required based on campus and major.

## CALIFORNIA GENERAL EDUCATION TRANSFER CURRICULUM (CAL-GETC) Cont.

### FIRST-TIME FRESHMAN

Students who complete this program apply to UC/CSU as first-time freshmen and may earn Cal-GETC certification from Cerritos College.


Cal-GETC certification may satisfy lower-division general education requirements at participating UC and CSU campuses. Additional coursework may be required based on campus and major.

### TRANSFER STUDENT

Students earn a Cal-GETC certification.

Students who wish to apply as transfer applicants must enroll in and complete coursework at a community college after high school graduation.


