

Freshman Registration 2021-2022

Steps to Register for next year's classes:

1. Log-in to **studentconnection.dusd.net**
 - a. Registration begins **March 8th** at 2:00pm and closes on **March 12th** at 11:59pm
 - b. Username: Student ID #
 - c. Password: Student initials + Date of Birth Example:(jm02/02/02)
2. Click to select the option for next school year **2021-2022**
3. Click on the + for **Requests**
4. Some courses will be pre-loaded for you and cannot be removed. If you will not be taking one of these courses, your counselor will remove it for you.
5. Click on the link to **Add/Edit Requests**
6. Under **Select Course to Add**, click on a course to view the course description
7. Click on the **Add Selected Course** button to add that course as one of your requests
8. Any courses with an **X** before the course number may be deleted
9. If you would like to take an **AP/H level course**, add the course(s). Counselors will consult with the subject teacher for their approval
10. If you applied to AVID, counselor will add you to the class upon acceptance
11. Students will be added to Yearbook, ASB, Link Crew, and Dance by the counselor upon teacher approval
12. Click on **Submit** to save course requests additions and changes
