





Technology is combined with concepts of storyboarding, scripting and pre-production giving students an opportunity to **think** and **defend** their ideas. Students work individually and as a team to create videos for the morning broadcast that are shared on Good Morning Griffiths. The broadcast is seen daily throughout the whole school and is designed to provide relevant information and entertainment to the students and staff of Griffiths Middle School.

Video Production is part of the Film and Media Arts Pathways offered at Downey and Warren High School.



In Griffiths Middle School's Green Architecture program, students learn how to apply STEAM concepts to the fields of architecture and construction by exploring dimensioning, measuring and sustainability.



Computer Science



Griffiths Middle School's Computer Science program teaches students the skills necessary to become globally competitive and successful.

In the GMS Computer Science program, students learn to create apps that can be used on their tablets and smartphones. As they create these apps, students use critical thinking skills to solve a problem through programming, while also developing their engineering skills.



Robotics

During their time in Griffiths Middle School's Robotics Program, students will learn and understand the design process. This class helps students recognize the creativity and innovation that goes into creating technological products. Our students are encouraged to unleash their own creative concepts and actualize their ideas. This is done by exposing students to Computer Aided Drawing (CAD), 3D printing, and lots of hand-on applications.
