Imperial Elementary does this through PBIS. What does PBIS mean? PBIS is a system for maintaining a safe and effective school. PBIS includes schoolwide procedures intended to support all students and staff in all settings. Our goal is to create and maintain a safe and productive learning environment where teachers can teach and *all* students can learn!

Our PBIS School Motto is BE KIND, BE POSITIVE, BE YOUR BEST!

Our PBIS Expectations are

- ★ Be Respectful
- ★ Be Responsible
- ★ Be Safe

As part of our process, here are some of the ways we work to build a PBIS community:

- Consistently teach and refer to our school wide expectations
- Provide students with more praise than correction
- Talk to each other with respect using a positive voice tone
- Actively engage everyone in the class during instruction
- Use prompting and redirecting as we teach
- Provide frequent, immediate and explicit feedback

We also have a schoolwide system of consequences:

- Minor Offenses (1-3)
 - Documented with a Yellow or Blue Slip
 - Shared with Families on Class Dojo
 - Teacher and Family implement positive behavior strategies and support
- 4th Minor Offense in the <u>same</u> category
 - Office Data Referral
 - Meet with a School Administrator
 - Administrator, Teacher and Family implement positive behavior strategies and support
