Our Vice Principal, Mr. Naval

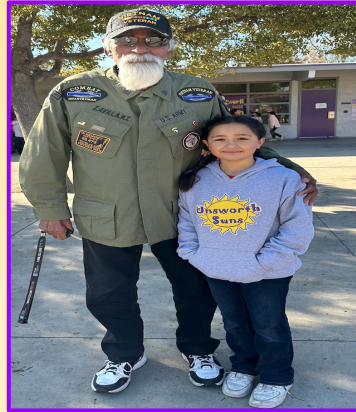
Our mission at Unsworth is to prepare your child academically for lifelong success.

Dear Families,

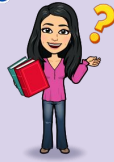
i-Ready is an online program for reading and mathematics that will help your child's teacher determine your student's needs, personalize their learning, and monitor progress throughout the school year.

i-Ready Personalized Instruction provides students with the lessons based on their individual skill level and needs, so your student can learn at a pace that is just right for them. These lessons are fun and interactive to keep your student engaged as they learn.

How can you help at home?

- ❖ Make sure students have what they need:
 - A quiet place to work on i-Ready lessons and activities, and a fully charged ipad
- ❖ Help them focus:
 - Encourage them to take their time, ask questions, and write things down
- ❖ Keep students motivated:
 - Explain that working on i-Ready will help them continue their learning and make sure they are ready for the next grade level
- ❖ Help them track progress:
 - Check in at the end of their lessons. Ask them to tell you or write down what they have learned and if they have questions. Monitor them as they work, but do not help them to answer questions.
- ❖ Celebrate their progress:
 - Celebrate milestones, such as passing a lesson or reaching a goal by rewarding hard work and focus.
