- A. To qualify for CSF membership this semester, follow these guidelines:
- 1. You must earn a *minimum of ten (10) CSF points* from last semester’s grades.
 - a) The **first 4 points** must be from LIST I, but all 10 points may come from this list.
 - b) The **first 7 points** (including the four points described in “a”) must be from LIST I and II.
 - c) The **final 3 points** may come from any LIST (I, II, or III).
 - 2. You may use NO MORE THAN 5 COURSES to qualify.
 - 3. No CSF points are given for grades (or Credit/CR) earned in PE, classes to replace PE (Marching band or Cheer), subjects repeated to raise a grade, or Teacher’s Aide.
 - 4. CSF points are earned as follows:
 - a grade of A = 3 points
 - a grade of B = 1 point
 - a grade of C = 0 points
 - a grade of D or F or NC **disqualifies** you this semester
 - a citizenship grade of 4 or 5 **disqualifies** you this semester
- *One additional point shall be granted for a grade of A or B in an AP, IB or Honors course, up to a **maximum of two such points per semester**.*
- B. IMPORTANT: CSF is not automatic. You must reapply each semester. Membership cannot be granted retroactively. CSF membership is always based on grades earned in the previous *semester*, never on quarter grades.
- C. To be eligible, you must present a printed copy, of your **June 2025** marks with this application. To access your marks, log into your Student Connection account → Menu Items → Documents → click 2024-25 Semester TWO Report Card → Print.
- D. Only courses taken last semester may be used.
- E. College courses count the same as high school courses; no extra points are given.
