#59 ORAL COMMUNICATIONS Ms. Rademaker expressed her regrets for not being able to attend the Annual State of the Schools breakfast on Friday, October 5, 2018 and commented that it appeared to have been well attended from the photos she saw posted on social media.

Mr. Kennedy shared that he attended the Annual State of the Schools breakfast and believes that it is a great Public Relations activity for the District. He feels that bringing the community in and informing them of what is going on in the schools is an excellent event since it helps us get along better with our city council, police department and businesses in and around the city.

Mr. Kennedy shared that he is looking forward to the Downey/Warren game on Friday, October 19th and is keeping his fingers crossed that Downey wins.

Mr. Kennedy shared that he is also looking forward to the administration building at Warren High School being renamed/dedicated in Bobby Samperi's honor on Tuesday, October 23rd at 3:30 pm.
