- We never saw a drop-off in attendance. It was steady throughout!

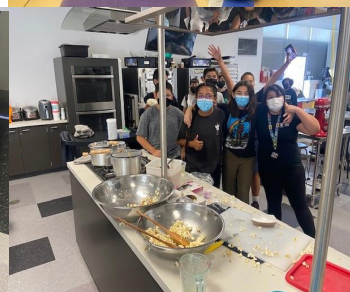

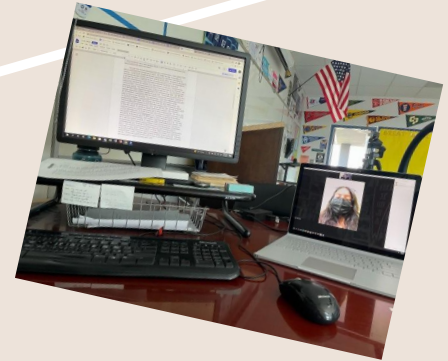


### Bears University Seminar (BUS) Incoming 12th Gr: College Essay Writing
