What a better way to start our week than with focusing on our emotional well-being with a little breathing and care exercise.

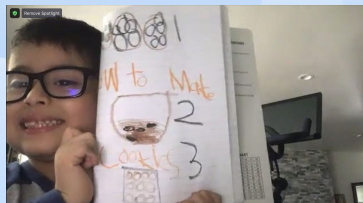
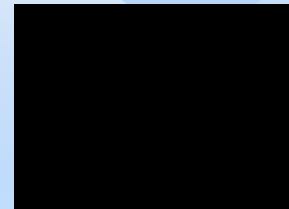
Restorative Wednesday:
