



Virtual Academy Expansion 2022-2023

- Virtual Academy will expand to grades K-12 for the 2022-2023 school year
- Transitioning to Secondary Education Department
- Projected enrollment as of June 2, 2022: 450 students grades K-12
- Offering synchronous online learning with direct teacher instruction
- Maintaining a smaller asynchronous Independent Study option for highly motivated and self-directed learners
