Stauffer Middle School's new gym is 85% complete. The contractor is currently finishing interior framing, and installing all drywall. Painting is also happening at the same time. Concrete foundations have been poured in place for the two story buildings (north and south). There are continuous efforts on moving forward with underground utilities and remaining foundation work.

The work around the existing lunch area is 90% complete. All three permanent lunch shelters, concrete and synthetic turf has been installed and complete. Next steps are painting, landscape work and existing planter beautification.
