- They help **build** and **sustain** systems for future HRC reps/work.




DUSD Equity Plan Goals & Progress Highlights

HRC & Equity Plan Updates


- 100% of sites have *HRC Padlets* to communicate equity plan implementation updates to sites.
- Eric Jensen Professional Learning book study Eric Jensen's Teaching with Poverty & Equity in Mind ongoing.
- Established benchmarks for our *Board Goal #6* to continue improve in our areas of growth through data collection & analysis.
- HRC Subcommittee was developed and collected data for developing a resource bank for multicultural and heritage celebration resources based on input gathered from HRC reps, PAC, and DELAC.
- Building capacity of our HRC reps with our continued communication protocols after our quarterly meetings.



Equity Plan Progress Monitoring

Highlights

- Expansion of PD to Classified Groups
 - Spring 2025 DFEO Training on HRC & Equity in DUSD to 200 participants.
 - SIA Training Belonging & Culturally Responsive Teaching
- Continuing PD with our District Leaders
 - 6 Professional Learning Sessions with our district administrators for the 2024-2025 school year.
 - Book Study Eric Jensen's Engaging Students with Poverty in Mind
 - Administrators are taking the Jensen work back to their sites, making an impact with their staff, and planning for the 2025-2026 year.
 - Administrators provided feedback at every PD session on areas of strength, improvement, and needs for follow up sessions.
 - Over 90% of administrators rated the professional learning effective or highly effective.

- Infusing *AVID strategies* such as focused note taking and Socratic Seminars.




