HISTORY & TIMELINE

WHS:

- 2008: Teen Connection Established at WHS
- 2014: Staff v Students Kickball Game at WHS
- 2015: Abilities Awareness Week @ WHS Introduced
- 2016: Partnership with Special Olympics was Formed
- 2018: Unified PE and Art Built into Master Schedule
- 2019: WHS Became a Special Olympics National Banner School & Received ESPN Recognition
- 2019: CIF Established Unified Track & Field
- 2021: Current WHS Students Sam Lara & Kate Gonzalez Become Special Olympics U.S. Youth Ambassadors
- 2022: Two WHS Unified Pairs Compete in Track & Field at the Special Olympics National Games in Florida



2023-2024:

- The District Establishes a Unified Sports District Lead & Two High School Lead Positions
- DEA “Better Together Grants” Match Special Olympics Grant Funding
- Negotiations Take Place for Stipends for Site Liaisons and Coaches
- Unified Sports is Introduced to DUSD Middle Schools
- Doty Middle School Adds Unified PE to Master Schedule
- Elementary Schools Begin Inclusion & Abilities Awareness Weeks



2024-2025:

- Negotiated Stipends for Site Liaisons and Coaches go live!
- All four Middle Schools and DHS become “Unified Champions” Schools
- PBS Films a Segment for “Inside California’s Schools” on Unified Sports in DUSD
- DUSD Wins CSBA Golden Bell Award for Unified Sports in the Category of “Equitable Resource Distribution”



2025-2026:

- 19 DUSD Schools are Considered “Unified Champion” Schools
- Formalizing MOU with SOSC in an effort to become a “Unified Champions” District!!
- April 2026: Biggest Unified Track Meet in Planning Process - 16 Middle & High Schools
- May 2026: DHS Athletic Leadership Hosting 1st Annual DHS/WHS Unified Sports Banquet

WHAT IS A UNIFIED CHAMPION SCHOOL?

Special Olympics Unified Champion Schools aim to promote social inclusion through intentionally planned and implemented activities affecting systems-wide change in TK–12 schools and beyond.

Three Core Components

1. Inclusive Sports (aka: “Unified Sports”)
2. Inclusive Youth Leadership Opportunities
3. Whole School Engagement

What a Unified Champion School “looks like” can vary greatly from school to school, based on the needs, goals, schedules, and other factors unique to each school.

HOW 19 DUSD SCHOOLS BECAME UNIFIED CHAMPIONS SCHOOLS

- *Staff Members Possess a Vision & Desire for Inclusion at their School Site*
- *Staff Choose to Become Unified Champion Site Liaisons or Coaches*
- *Each Site Completes a Work Plan for the School Year & Submits this to SOSC*
- *SOSC Reviews & Approves Each Work Plan (sites receive a SOSC Shield, a banner, and often receive grant \$\$\$!)*
- *The School Site Implements Their Work Plan*
- *The School Site Culture Benefits*
- *The Cycle Repeats*
