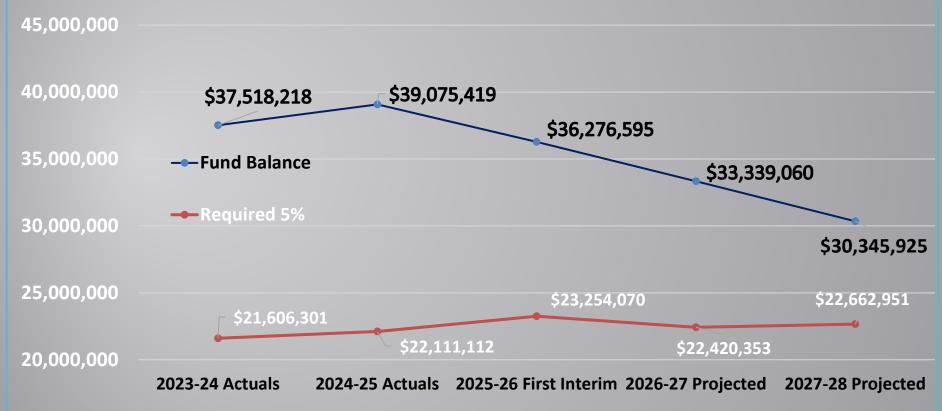
Financial Position - Multi-year projection

- Projected additional expenses based on trend in Special Education \$1.0 million each year

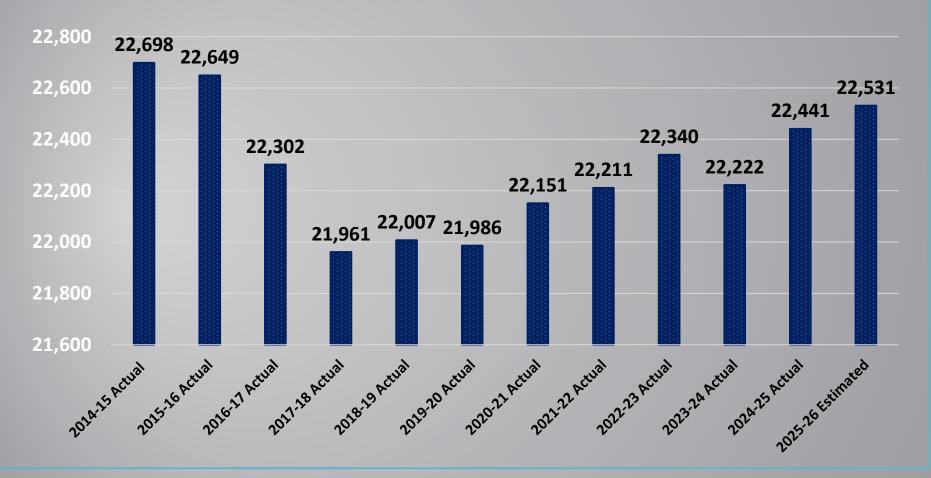
Restricted ending fund balance is Committed for Specific Purpose of the Program

- Use of General Fund Restricted Reserves over time

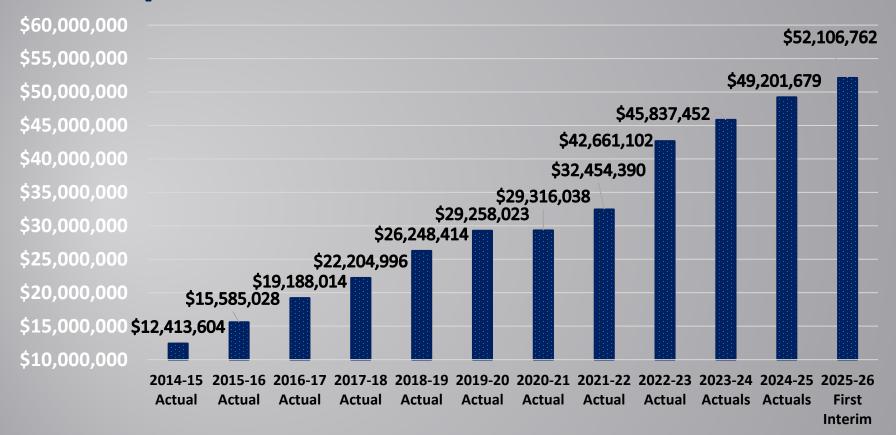
Unrestricted Ending Fund Balance 2023-24 to 2027-28



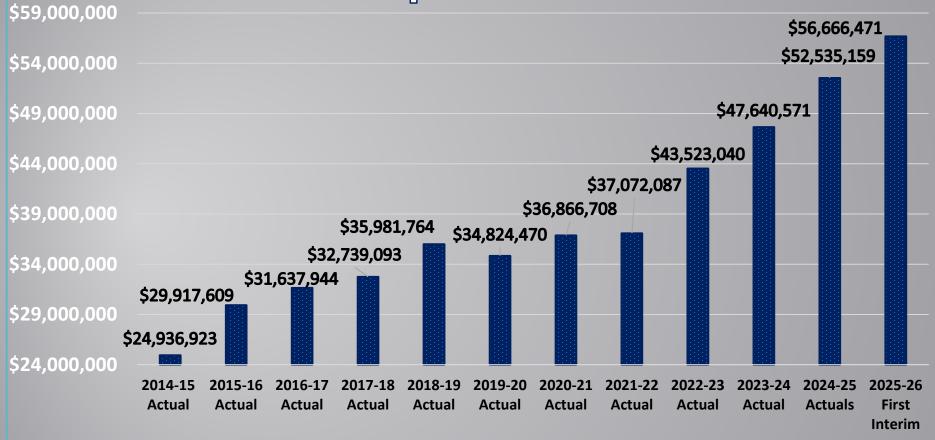
Student Enrollment 2014 to 2026
