Cerritos College- Department of Continuing Education

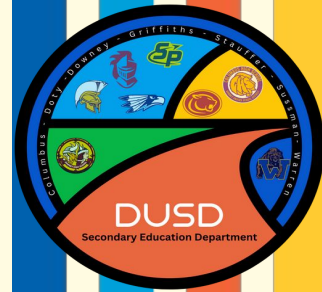
- Partnered with Dr. Graciela Vasquez, Dean of Continuing Education

Elite Academic Academy- **Peak Performance Program**

- Funded incoming 9th-12th grade student athletes interested in training with DUSD coaches over the summer

- Student athletes needing credit recovery, enrolled in up to 2 credit recovery classes with Elite and were still able to participate in all the Peak Performance athletic activities and field trips

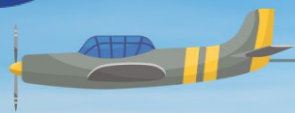
